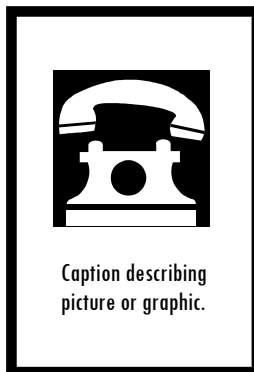

### About the bricks

Bricks that are purchased for the campaign are at a cost of \$50 for a standard 4"X8" brick or \$100 for a 8"X8" brick.

to be done. Large custom logos will have to be done by the engraving company and will be quotes before any work begins

### What can you have on your brick

You can have anything engraved onto your brick. You can have family names, pet names, organizations, or just about anything reasonable. There are also a list of logos that you can have engraved onto your brick. Logos include all the armed forces, civic organizations and many more different symbols and signs.
