Did you know?

- There are **23.2 million veterans** in the United States.
- 1.8 million veterans** are women.
- 9 million veterans** are over the age of 65.
- 1.9 million** are under the age of 35.

Among the nation's living veterans, approximately 2.6 million served in **World War II**, 2.8 million served in the **Korean War**, 7.8 million during the **Vietnam** era and 5.2 million in **Gulf War to present**. There are 6 million peacetime veterans.
